

Danilo Zolo

Danilo Zolo (Rijeka, 1936) is professor of Philosophy of Law and of Philosophy of International Law at the University of Florence. He studied jurisprudence at the University of Florence and in 1966 he obtained also the Teacher's Diploma in History and Philosophy. He has been Associate Researcher at Boston University, and Visiting Fellow at the University of Cambridge, University of Pittsburgh, Harvard University and the University of Princeton. In 1993 he was Jemolo Fellow at the Centre for European Studies, Nuffield College, Oxford. In 1999 he was Visiting Professor at the Federal University of Paraiba, Joao Pessoa (Brazil) and in 2001-2005 he delivered courses of lectures at universities of Argentina, Brazil, Mexico and Colombia. In 2000 he founded JURA GENTIUM, Centre for Philosophy of International Law and Global Politics and the homonymous International E-Journal. He is member of the *Academia Europaea*. He is author of many essays concerning political philosophy, epistemology of the social sciences, General system theory, theory of social complexity, and philosophy of international law and international relations. His present research concerns the theory of 'rule of law', the doctrine of human rights and the processes of global integration.
